Where is the YMCA After School Program held?

YMCA After School Programs are available onsite at **Blair, Bradley Creek, Parsley, Pine Valley and Parsley and College Park Elementary Schools**. Our after school program is also available at the Wilmington Family YMCA and transportation is provided* from **Forest Hills, Rachel Freeman, Gregory, Winter Park and College Park Elementary Schools** and **Cape Fear Center for Inquiry**. Other bus runs can be added with a minimum pickup of 5 children. *Requires a one time transportation fee of \$90.

What if my child does not attend a participating school? Our After School Program is open to all children and is available at the Wilmington Family YMCA. You may drop your child off beginning at 2:30pm.

What are program hours?

All YMCA after school programs operate from school dismissal until 6:00pm., Monday through Friday.

Who directs the After School Program?

What We Believe:

The Wilmington Family YMCA is committed to providing an environment for children not just for fun, but will aid in the development of positive character traits. Our staff embraces the values of Caring, Respect, Responsibility, Honesty and Faith. These values extend into all areas of your child's life giving them self-assurance and maturity. We are confident that our after school programs will foster in your child an improved understanding of the benefits gained through these areas. At the YMCA our goal is to continue to build strong kids, strong families and strong communities.

What kinds of activities are planned for my child?

Wilmington Family YMCA after school offers a full array of activities. Games, arts & crafts, assemblies, skits, plays, devotions, challenges and homework time are just some of the exciting opportunities awaiting your child.

What is a typical daily schedule?

Daily schedules will include:

- WOW Time (Outside and/or gym activities)
- Bathroom, Water and Snack Time
- Homework (Quiet time for studying, reading or drawing.)
- Focus Time (Discover science, music, culture & history.)
- Devotion and Golden Moments
- Closing Assembly (Character Trait Recognition)

What is the Rides Out pick up policy?

Rides Out begins at 5:15pm and continues until 6:00pm. Children are not released to anyone that is not on their authorized pick-up list. If the child's parent/s cannot pick up their child, written consent from the parent must be sent to the staff. The person picking up your child must present a picture ID at time of pick up.

What does After School Fee Cover?

The After School Program provides after school care for all 180 days as outlined by New Hanover School system traditional schedule. The YMCA After School Program covers all teacher workdays and staff development days for five day participants. During teacher workdays, a full day of care is provided at the YMCA. Parents can drop off their children at the YMCA beginning at 7:45am. **Holidays are separate and must be reserved and paid for one week prior to the holiday.**

Where is After School care provided on Early Release Days?

On early release/staff development days, after school care is provided at the Wilmington Family YMCA. Transportation is only provided for those participants on the regular YMCA pick up routes. However, we offer care to all registered participants and parents can drop off their children at the YMCA beginning at 11:45am.

What about Holidays?

The YMCA fee does not cover holidays. Parents may purchase Holiday childcare on any of the YMCA allotted days of service. Campers will need two snacks, lunch and swim clothes daily. **Holidays are separate and must be reserved and paid for one week prior to the holiday.**

What do I need to do if my child will be absent from After School?

If your child will not be attending the After School program, please call the YMCA Youth Office at 910-251-9622 ext. 255 and leave a message for Andrea. You may also email her prior to 2:00pm.

What is the payment policy?

All payments are due on the 25th of each month for the next month's service. A \$25.00 late fee will be added after the 1st of each month. Participation in the program may be canceled if payment is more than 5 days late. There will be a \$25.00 fee for all checks returned due to insufficient funds.

What is the cancellation policy?

A cancellation form must be filled out at the front desk of the Wilmington Family YMCA two weeks prior to the session start date. Please understand that non-attendance does not entitle a participant to a refund. This includes non-attendance due to illness, vacation or weather. Refunds are not granted after the program date has occurred.
